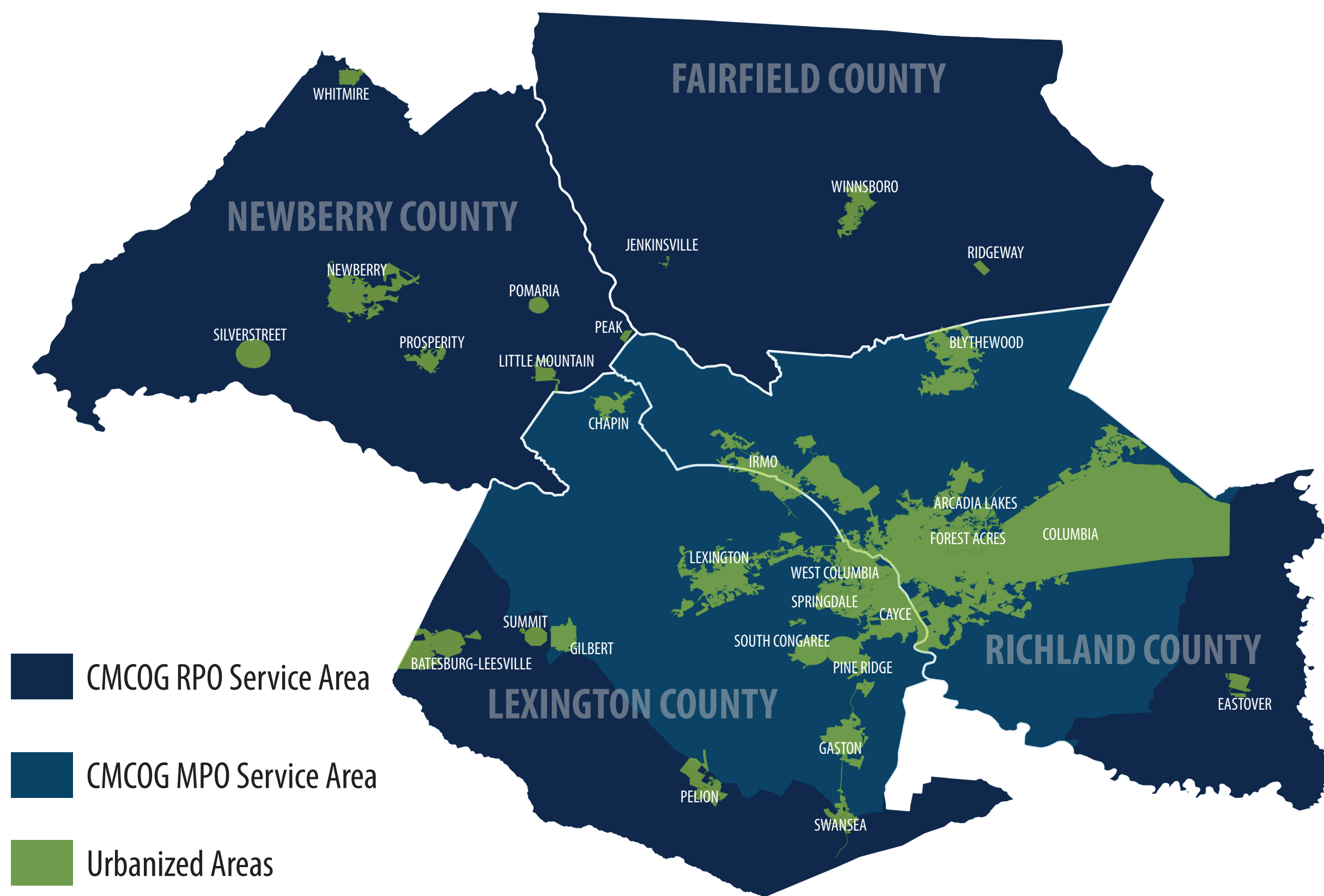


What is a LRTP?



- The CMCOG/COATS MPO study area is the designated MPO and RPO for all portions of Richland, Lexington, Fairfield, and Newberry counties.
- The COATS MPO, which serves an urbanized population greater than 200,000, is further classified as a Transportation Management Area (TMA).



The Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) identifies strategies and improvements to the transportation system needed to meet regional goals over the next 25 years. It helps guide decisions about which transportation projects to prioritize, like fixing roads and bridges, improving safety, and making travel more accessible for everyone.

The TIP includes projects that are funded to include phases of development such as engineering, right-of-way, and construction.

Projects in the TIP are implemented and/or constructed. Evaluation of the project benefits are included in the development of the next LRTP (5-year cycle).
